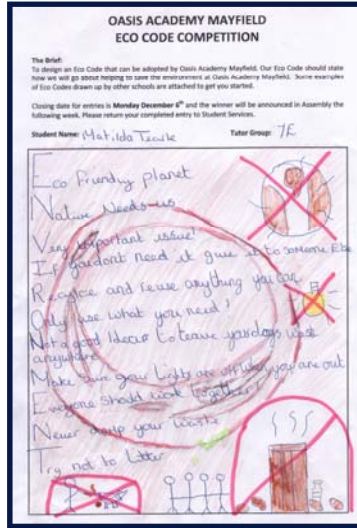
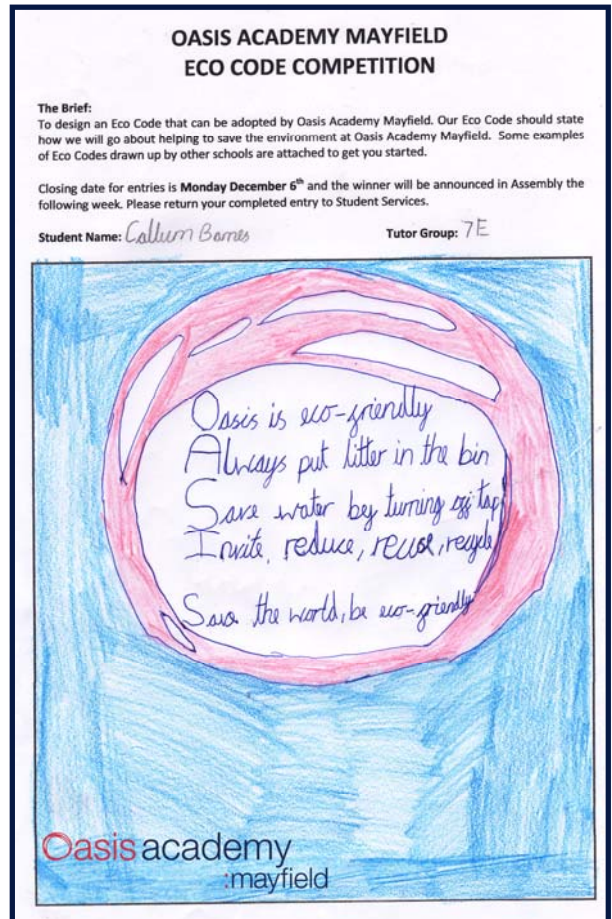


ECO SCHOOL NEWS
