PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Year 7 Explore Life At University

Year 9 Take A Closer Look At Science

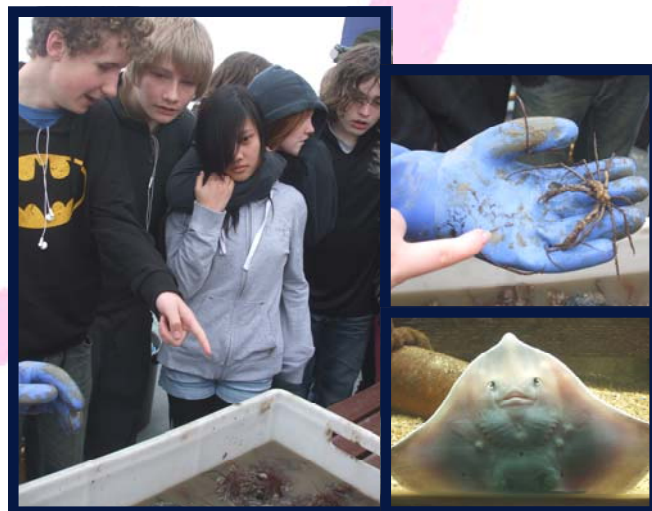
On Friday 1st April a group of Year 9 students visited the Oceanography Centre of the Southampton Solent University for the second part of their Aim Higher University Taster Experience.

The purpose of this visit was to encourage students to explore various scientific careers and what to expect from university life based around this.

After a briefing on the schedule for the day, students boarded a boat for a trip around the Solent in the direction of Victoria Country Park, to learn more about the study of marine biology. Water samples were taken to check the salinity and temperature of the sea, plus mud samples were also taken to observe the sea life of the area. Then it was back to dry land, where students were given an extensive tour of the Oceanography Centre and were even shown submarines being housed there!

Students agreed it was a fascinating trip which gave them an insight into why they learn sciences at school and how they are needed for certain career paths.

Initially this trip was organised for Year 10 students as part of their GCSE Exam preparations. However the Academy was lucky enough to be given extra places, which were then offered to students in KS3.

During the concert, students were treated to performances from the Southampton Youth Jazz Orchestra, Southampton Jazz Workshop and young people from across Southampton with a very special guest - Soweto Kinch. Soweto is an award-winning saxophonist with an amazing career including most recently collaborating on the BBC programme 'By Royal Appointment' with Goldie, Ms Dynamite and Guy Chambers.

The aim of the BBC project was to discover and coach a group of twelve people towards their first live performance in front of HM Prince Harry at Buckingham Palace.

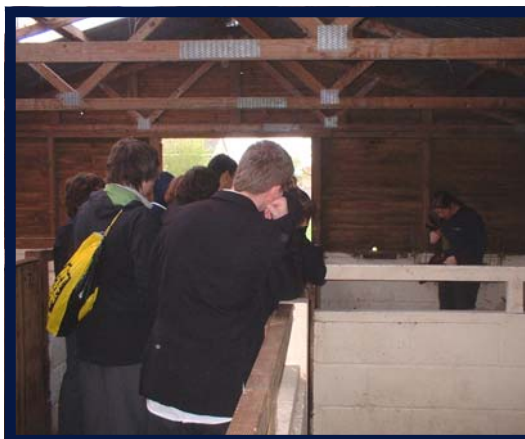

Down On The Farm

On Monday 4th April, two groups of KS4 students visited Down to Earth Farm in Millbrook as part of their ASDAN studies. ASDAN is a course delivered in over 6000 schools in England and Wales and is designed to develop student's skills in areas such as information handling, functional maths and home management. This visit provided them with valuable evidence to complete sections of their Leisure / World of Work modules.

Down to Earth is part of Lord's Hill Academy and is a fully functioning inner city farm based behind the Green Lane site. As well as the course skills, students can also gain experience in handling and feeding animals. The farm also has a wide variety of animal types including sheep, goats, chickens, cows, pigs and a rather large turkey. There is also a room dedicated to more unusual types including an albino hedgehog, a bearded dragon and some giant snails! The trip was thoroughly enjoyed by all.

Well done to Jordan and all the students who are part of 'Fusion', their hard work and professionalism was amazing. Thank you also to Mrs Clarke for all her help and commitment to the Young Enterprise Team.

Below is an extract from the company report, written by Josh Reisoglu - Managing Director and Jordan Cann - Deputy Managing Director

Fusion: Our Journey

At first communication between us was very poor, but this became better as we got further into our journey and split into two groups making it easier to manage. To help with the development of the company, we were assigned job roles. I was the Managing Director with overall responsibility for running the company.

At the start there were many challenges that I hadn't faced before; such as talking in front of people, giving people job roles and being held accountable for actions taken by the company. I now feel more comfortable in a working environment and have developed as a young leader along the way, as our group has developed into a small business.

Fusion has come a long way, from a disorganised group of Year 10 students, to a company that performs well and could achieve bigger profit margins if we had more time. We had a great set of products focussed mainly on confectionary, with a wide ranging target audience. Along the way, the company faced many difficulties; the main one being we were such a large company that at first we struggled to get organised. I overcame this by having a good working relationship with the Deputy Managing Director, Jordan Cann. Together we led the company forward in the development of products ideas and team members. Overall I have learnt about leadership and some of the qualities you need in business. I have improved on my ability to communicate confidently with students and teachers and developed my personal skills in organisation, presentation and dealing with conflict in a business environment. I have enjoyed the process very much and I look forward to being a peer mentor for next year's Young Enterprise Team.

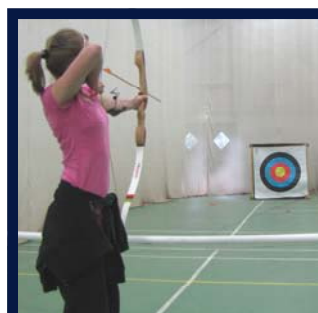

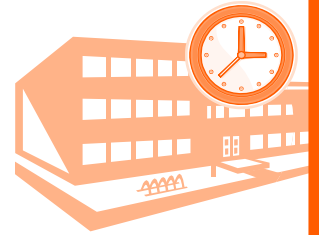
