### Class of 2020 Prom – Thursday 25 June 2020

It is with pleasure that we write to inform you of the details of the Year 11 Prom for the Class of 2020. We can confirm that the Prom will take place on **Thursday 25 June 2020** at **Chilworth Manor Hotel, Chilworth** from **7.00pm – 11.30pm**, with arrival from 6.00pm.

The total cost per ticket is **£40.00**, which will include venue hire, a mocktail on arrival, a formal 3-course meal with a soft drink and the cost of the DJ for the evening. Once students receive a formal invitation to Prom in May, further detail regarding payment will be communicated.

The Prom for Oasis Academy Mayfield is a privilege and honour to be a part of; the Prom is a spectacular celebration of our students and their 5 years of dedication and hard work, whilst also celebrating the next steps they are about to take as they end their time with us.

As you are aware, these final months of learning are **vital** for your child's success in their final exams this summer. Therefore, we have an expected standard of ongoing attendance, behaviour and focus during this time. In order for there to be clarity regarding the criteria that needs to be achieved for students to attend the Prom, and more importantly so that you do not incur any unnecessary expense, the following criteria will apply.

Starting from week commencing Monday 02 March 2020, students must:

- earn a minimum of 600 ePraise points. Points are awarded for attendance, progress, effort and attainment in lessons, as well as attendance at intervention and other after school events.
- achieve at least 5 weeks (or equivalent) of 100% attendance from this date.
- have no serious behaviour incidents. Serious incidents will include failure or refusal of shadow, receiving an Internal Exclusion (IE) or a fixed term exclusion (FTE).
- 100% attendance at all final GCSE examinations in the summer.

If your child has any questions regarding the content of this letter, please ask them to speak with me or Mr S Knight. Any student not meeting these expectations can have their Prom invitation revoked at any time up to the date of the Prom.

We urge you to support and encourage your child in meeting or exceeding these expectations. It is important that their remaining time at Oasis Academy Mayfield is focused on achieving the best outcomes possible. The Prom is always a fantastic occasion and I am very much looking forward to welcoming the Class of 2020 to their Prom in June.
